

Registration for all ITFU members, federations, and invited schools will be completed through the ITFU sports website (www.itfu-asia.com). Registration will be open from March 1, 2026, to April 1, 2026, at 24:00 Almaty time.

Participants must be accompanied by a master instructor, and full payment is due upon completion of registration.

After these registration stages, changes or cancellations will not be possible before or after this period.

The entry fee is non-refundable in the event of withdrawal from the tournament.

✓ **Kolsai Lakes**



Kolsai Lakes is a mountainous area in the Almaty region, approximately 300 km from Almaty. Turquoise lakes, pine forests, and stunning views await. The best time to visit is from May to October. Ideal for walks, photography, and outdoor recreation.

✓ Charyn Canyon



Charyn is a beautiful canyon in the Almaty region of Kazakhstan, approximately **200 km from Almaty**, and part of the **Charyn National Park**.

It stretches for **154 km**, with some sections reaching depths of up to **370 m**. The most famous area is the **Valley of Castles**, where the cliffs resemble fortresses and towers.

The canyon is home to rare plants, including the **Sogdian ash**, and diverse fauna. It is a popular destination for **tourism, hiking, photography, and outdoor activities**; it is a 3-4 hour drive from Almaty.

✓ City of nomads



The Nomad City, or Nomad Fortress, on the Ili River in Kapchagay is a unique structure built specifically for the filming of the cult classic "Nomad" in 2004. During production, a decision was made to construct a fake set for a medieval oriental fortress. Thus, a real medieval city emerged in the middle of the Kazakh steppe.

✓ Tamgaly-Tas ("writing stones")



Tamgaly-Tas ("written stones" or "stones with signs") is a site along the Ili River 120 km north of Almaty, Kazakhstan, known for its ancient petroglyphs (rock carvings), including images of Buddha, deities, and ancient Turkic runic inscriptions left by different peoples in different eras, making it a unique historical and cultural site popular for tourism and festivals.
